

ORDINANCE NO. 16

(Ordinance Series 2020-1)

AN ORDINANCE SETTING THE COMPENSATION OF ALL ELECTED CITY OFFICERS, APPOINTED OFFICIALS AND EMPLOYEES OF THE CITY OF DRUID HILLS.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMISSIONERS OF CITY OF DRUID HILLS:

SECTION I. The legislative body of the City shall by this ordinance fix the compensation of every elected official not later than the regularly scheduled Commission meeting in May in the year the official is elected. An elected official’s compensation shall not be changed after the election or during their term of office.

(a) In order to equate the compensation of Mayors and Commissioners with the purchasing power of the dollar, the Department for Local Government computes by the second Friday in February of every year the annual increase or decrease in the consumer price index of the preceding year by using 1949 as the base year in accordance with section 246 of the Constitution of Kentucky, which provides that the Mayor in cities of first class shall be paid at a rate no greater than twelve thousand dollars (\$12,000.00) per annum and Mayors in cities other than the first class and Commissioners shall be paid at a rate no greater than seven thousand two hundred dollars (\$7,200.00) per annum.

(b) The legislative body of the City shall set the compensation of these officers in accordance with KRS 83A.070 at a rate no greater than that stipulated by the Department for Local Government.

SECTION II. The legislative body of the City shall fix compensation of the city employees and nonelected city officers in accordance with the personnel and pay classification plan and/or annual budget which shall be adopted by ordinance.

SECTION III. The current compensation schedule for elected officials shall be as listed on this ordinance.

SECTION IV. This ordinance shall be effective from and after passage, approved and publication as required by law.
