2. Off Street Parking

Discussion related to the parking pads and Ordinance 5 (Parking Ordinance). Attorney Cato provided input related to the legal aspects for both the City and Louisville Metro. Clerk Strebel also provided suggested wording for a revised ordinance. Additional discussion will continue at the next meeting.
