Legal Counsel Report			

The Commissioners discussed the change in venue and the impact on the current ordinance. Broadway Baptist is now using the Family Life Cener for other purposes and asked the City to use the Church Conference Center. The Mayor will discuss and confirm the meeting location moving forward with Broadway Baptist Church.

Druid Hills received a legal notice related to medical cannabis. Mr. Cato informed the commission that this notice did not have an impact on Druid Hills as there is no retail property in the City.

#### **Old Business**

#### 1. Leaf Pickup

A motion was made by Commissioner Lloyd and seconded by Commissioner Gibbs to amend the current sanitation contract with Rumpke to modify the yard waste weekly fall pickup to November 1st through November 30th. Previously, the dates were October 15th through November 15th. The motion was approved unanimously by all present. The Mayor signed the amendment, and the Clerk will provide it to Rumpke.

The Mayor will also explore a leaf pickup similar to that of St. Matthews. This will be discussed at an upcoming meeting.

#### 2. Rumpke Pickup Complaints

Commissioner Gibbs provided feedback that Rumpke has missed pickup on Olympic on several occasions. Mayor Westfall noted that there have been complaints on Elfin as well. Mayor Westfall will request a meeting with Rumpke's representative, Chris Pierce.

#### 3. Electric to Street Entrances

The Mayor will be meeting with LG&E and an electrician to get quotes on bringing electrical service to the street entrances.

#### 4. Off Street Parking

The Mayor received a bid for striping on Elfin and Druid Hills for approximately \$2,270. There was discussion about having all roads controlled by the City striped. The Mayor will request a quote on including Olympic.

In addition, to have stop bars painted would cost \$360 and repainting the speed humps would be an additional \$2,250.

#### 5. Block Party

Two option were discussed for the Block Party. A big band which would play for about 45 minutes for \$500 and a bluegrass band that would play for up to 2 hours for \$500. Discussions about having both groups perform occurred. Additional information will be provided at the next meeting.

The Mayor will check with the owner of the open lot at 3938 Druid Hills Road about using the site for the Block Party.

Also discussed was the need to block the street and if any refreshments (punch/cookies) would be provided.

#### 6. Other Old Business

Commissioner Lloyd informed the Commission that Holy Trinity School has placed a banner on the light post at Napanee and Chenoweth.
