Minutes

A motion was made to approve by Commissioner Jobson and seconded by Commissioner D. Westfall. The motion carried unanimously by all present to approve the minutes with the spelling of paving company changed to 'Schark'.

Old Business

1. City Clerk will continue research a company to scan City documents.
2. Mayor Westfall will reach out to the J. Andrews regarding Ethics Officer position.

New Business

1. The Rumpke sanitation schedule will be placed on several easily accessible places on the City of Druid Hills website.
2. The City Clerk will create a newsletter to be mailed to residents in March for the first quarter of 2026.
3. Mayor Westfall brought information regarding elected official pay in other cities for the board of Commissioners to review. Mayor Westfall suggested a raise for the elected Commissioners and Mayor who are elected on June 2, 2026 to take place starting January 1, 2027. The board feels the Commissioner pay should stay the same, but the elected Mayor's pay should be raised to \$1,200 a year.
 - a. A motion was made by Commissioner J. Gibbs and seconded by Commissioner D. Westfall to keep the salary the same for the Commissioners and raise the salary of the elected Mayor to \$1,200 a year starting January 1, 2027. The motion carried unanimously by all present to approve the elected Mayor's salary.
4. Mayor Westfall spoke with Chuck Berger, the design manager for the Chenoweth Lane project.
 - a. The project scope is to improve safety and visibility for both cars and pedestrians. This includes removal of trees, bushes, and sidewalk improvements.
 - b. The project is projected to finish early Fall 2026.
