2. The Computer Doctor picked up all of the City of Druid Hills documents and is scanning them for preservation. They should have everything completed in three weeks.
3. Ashton Advertising provided a proposal for a website redesign and build.
 - a. Mayor Westfall will send the proposal to the Commissioners for review
 - b. Recommendations were made to make the website ADA-compliant
 - c. Ashton Advertising asked if the City of Druid Hills wants to stay with .gov or if we would be open to switching to .org. The .gov domain has limitations.
4. The sign on St. Matthews Avenue/Napanee is leaning. Commissioner Westfall is looking into having it fixed.
